
Community Engagement Collective



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Community Engagement Collective (CEC) is a community-based nonprofit organization serving Cincinnati communities. The mission of CEC is to foster community engagement through community-engaged events and research. Since 2017, CEC has facilitated eight events that served 390 members in various communities. The success of these initiatives was due to the relationships built with funders and community members. CEC strives to implement programming that directly addresses needs ranging from inclusion to access to resources within communities. CEC values community voice at the center of programming and recognizes the need to address gaps through innovation.

Black, Indigenous and People of Color (BIPOC) communities lack exclusive resources for mental and behavioral health needs. Mental and behavioral health needs have increased during the pandemic (Interact for Health 2021), and social distancing can increase stress and anxiety (CDC, 2021). For those in need of mental health treatment and seek BIPOC providers, no resource included providers that self-identify as BIPOC in Cincinnati.

Community Engagement Collective chose to address this community need by launching the first BIPOC Mental and Behavioral Health Directory within Cincinnati. The directory launch is the foundation for creating a strategy for having a consistent resource for communities to address this gap. All providers in the directory completed a survey to share the information included in each profile. In addition, each provider self-identified as BIPOC and provided direct mental and behavioral health services. The motivation behind this work stems from recognizing that there is a need for connecting BIPOC people with BIPOC providers.

As this is the first directory of this kind locally, learning will come from this. We welcome your feedback and future collaboration.
